## WHAT IS TAG?

UC Irvine's Transfer Admission Guarantee Program (TAG) guarantees admission to well-qualified students from all California community colleges. Admission to most majors at UC Irvine can be guaranteed through TAG for transfer students who meet the eligibility requirements and complete the procedure required to obtain a transfer admission guarantee.

Completing the online TAG Checklist process and submitting it to UCI electronically, in combination with applying to UC Irvine, will result in an early admissions evaluation for fall 2010. ### TAG Submission Period:

September 1 – October 15, 2009 for Fall 2010

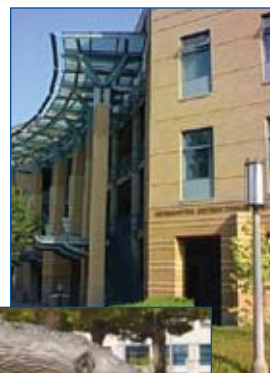
## WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR TAG?

A community college applicant who:

- has completed the last 30 semester or 45 quarter UC transferable units at one or more California community colleges;
- was enrolled at one or more California community colleges for at least two terms, excluding summer sessions;
- last attended a California community college, excluding summer sessions;
- has maintained a minimum GPA of 3.0 in all UC - transferable course work by the end of summer 2009 for fall 2010 admission;
- has completed one transferable math course with a C grade or better by the end of summer 2009 for fall 2010 admission;
- has completed the first transferable English course with a C grade or better by the end of summer 2009 for the fall 2010 admission (second transferable English course must be met by spring 2010);
- will complete 60 transferable semester units or 90 quarter units by the end of spring 2010 for fall 2010 admission;
- will complete all additional requirements for chosen major including course prerequisites and minimum subject GPA prior to UC Irvine enrollment. View additional major requirements on the back of this flyer.

## PROCEDURES - to obtain your Transfer Admission Guarantee

1. Enter your personal identification information online at [www.admissions.uci.edu/tag](http://www.admissions.uci.edu/tag).
2. Ensure you meet the minimum eligibility requirements for your chosen major outlined on the back of this flyer. All eligibility requirements must be completed prior to the UC Application filing period for fall 2010 admission.
3. Complete and submit the TAG checklist online no later than **October 15, 2009** for fall 2010 admission; including an advising session with your Transfer Center Director if required.
4. Apply for admission to UC Irvine for fall 2010 during the UC Application filing period, November 1-30, 2009.
5. Indicate your TAG eligibility on the UC Application.
6. Complete the steps required to maintain your UC Irvine Transfer Admission Guarantee.



## WHO IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR TAG?

A student who is not TAG eligible has:

- first transferable English composition course in progress;
- first transferable math course in progress;
- a degree from a four-year college/university;
- any foreign/international coursework;
- any coursework from a four-year college/university (exception: coursework completed at a UC and the applicant left the UC in good standing);
- any coursework from an out-of-state college/university.

PLEASE NOTE: Many students who are not eligible for TAG are exceptionally well-qualified and are strongly encouraged to apply for admission to UC Irvine through the regular application process during the filing period. For fall 2010 admission, the UC Application filing period is November 1-30, 2009. Apply online at [www.ucop.edu/pathways](http://www.ucop.edu/pathways).

**BASIC REQUIREMENTS**

- Have a minimum overall GPA of 3.0
- Complete 60 transferable units by Spring 2010

**SCHOOL/MAJOR****ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS****CLAIRE TREVOR****SCHOOL OF THE ARTS**

All majors, except Arts and Humanities, Dance, and Music

- No specific course requirements

Note: *Dance* and *Music* majors are admitted by audition only; admission to the *Arts and Humanities* major requires departmental approval, therefore they are not available for TAG. Transfer students must select another Arts major and may apply to Arts & Humanities early in their first year at UC Irvine.

**SCHOOL OF BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES****All majors**

- Complete one year of general chemistry with lab with a grade of B or better in each course
- Complete one year of general biology with lab equivalent to UC Irvine's BIO SCI 93, 94, and 100 lab with a grade of C or better in each course

Note: Admission to *Biochemistry and Molecular Biology*, *Developmental and Cell Biology*, *Genetics*, *Microbiology & Immunology*, *Neurobiology*, or *Plant Biology* requires department approval; therefore they are not available for TAG.

**THE HENRY SAMUELI SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING****All majors, except Computer Science and Engineering**

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in required courses
- Complete one year of calculus
- Complete one year of calculus-based physics with appropriate labs
- Complete additional approved courses specified for the major you have selected

**THE HENRY SAMUELI SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING and DONALD BREN SCHOOL OF INFORMATION AND COMPUTER SCIENCES****Computer Science and Engineering**

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in required courses
- Complete one year of calculus
- Complete one year of calculus-based physics with appropriate labs
- Complete one year of programming with at least one course in object-oriented programming (Java recommended)
- Complete one additional approved course for the CSE major

**COLLEGE OF HEALTH SCIENCES****Public Health Policy**

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in required courses
- Complete one year of courses in anthropology, economics, sociology, and/or psychology

**Public Health Sciences**

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in required courses
  - Complete one year of general biology and one year of general chemistry with laboratory
- Note: Admission to *Nursing Science* and *Pharmaceutical Sciences* requires department approval for enrollment; therefore they are not available for TAG. Admission to *Nursing Science* requires review of supplemental application.

**SCHOOL OF HUMANITIES**

All majors, except Humanities and Arts; Humanities (Interdisciplinary)

- No specific course requirements

Note: New students are not admitted directly to the Humanities and Arts or Humanities Interdisciplinary majors. Transfer students must select another Humanities major, and may apply to these interdisciplinary majors early in their first year at UC Irvine.

**DONALD BREN SCHOOL OF INFORMATION AND COMPUTER SCIENCES**

All majors, except Computer Science and Engineering

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 in required courses
- Complete one year of approved calculus, or for **Informatics** majors, one year of approved college mathematics
- Complete one year of transferable computer science courses involving concepts such as those found in Java, Scheme, C++, or other object-oriented or high-level programming

In addition, **Business Information Management** majors must:

- Complete one year of introductory accounting theory and practice
- Complete one year of micro- and macro-economics theory

**SCHOOL OF PHYSICAL SCIENCES****Chemistry**

- Complete one year of general chemistry with lab with minimum GPA of 3.0
- Complete one year of approved calculus with minimum GPA of 3.0

**Earth and Environmental Sciences (B.S.)**

- Complete one year of either general chemistry with lab or calculus-based physics with lab with minimum GPA of 3.0
- Complete one year of approved calculus with minimum GPA of 3.0

**Earth and Environmental Studies (B.A.)**

- Complete one year of general chemistry with laboratory or one year of biology with laboratory

**Mathematics**

- Complete one year of approved calculus with minimum GPA of 3.0

**Physics**

- Complete one year of calculus-based physics with lab with minimum GPA of 3.0
- Complete one year of approved calculus with minimum GPA of 3.0

**SCHOOL OF SOCIAL ECOLOGY**

**Criminology, Law and Society; Psychology and Social Behavior; Social Ecology; and Urban Studies**

- No specific course requirements

**SCHOOL OF SOCIAL SCIENCES**

**Business Economics, Economics, Quantitative Economics**

- Complete one year of micro- and macro-economics theory with a grade of B or better in each course
- Complete one year of approved calculus with a grade of B or better in each course

**All other Social Sciences majors**

- No specific course requirements
