

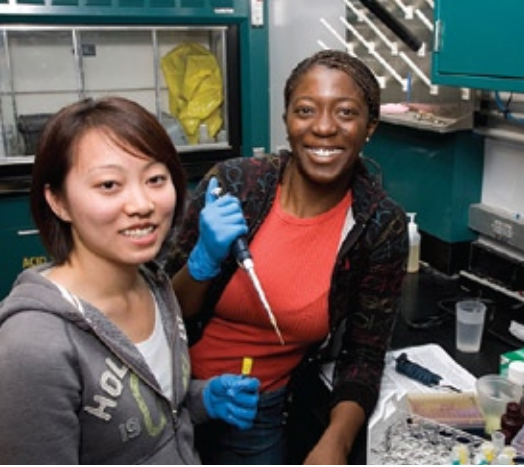

### A World of Study

UCI encourages study abroad and offers opportunities through the Education Abroad Program (EAP) and the International Opportunities Program (IOP). Students in EAP can experience a different culture while making progress toward their degree objectives. This UC overseas study program operates in cooperation with more than 150 host universities and colleges in 35 countries throughout the world. IOP provides information, counseling, and assistance in placing students in international study, short-term employment, field research, volunteer work, internships, and non-credentialed teaching abroad.

The Campuswide Honors Program (CHP) provides high-achieving students with the rigor and personal attention of a selective liberal arts college and the opportunities of a dynamic research university. ## Centered

## Outstanding

The university has won 25 national sports championships, including the 2007 men's volleyball national title. UCI competes in Division I of the NCAA, and is a member of the nine-school Big West Conference as well as the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation. Nineteen UCI athletes have gone on to earn Olympic medals. At the 2008 Olympics, UCI alumni and coaches participated in water polo, cycling, volleyball and sailing.



## Two Year Housing Guarantee

On-campus housing is guaranteed for two years to all incoming freshmen who meet application and contract-return deadlines.

### A Passion for Learning

Every student admitted to UCI has a strong record of academic and personal achievement. UCI freshmen have demonstrated their passion for learning and societal contribution by engaging consistently in honors and college-level courses, volunteering in civic and cultural activities, and aligning their leadership experiences with their personal and academic interests in areas such as the arts, entrepreneurship, research, and service projects.



### Admission

Admission to UCI is selective and all applicants receive a thorough review. The fall 2008 admissions profile includes these characteristics:

- Mean GPA 3.94 in university-approved courses
- Mean SAT verbal score 587
- Mean SAT math score 631
- Mean SAT writing score 598
- Average ACT composite score 26

In addition, the overwhelming majority of students completed at least four years of mathematics and a typical student completed six, full-year academic courses in their senior year. The average number of "A through G" courses, full-year, completed in grades 9 through 12 was 24.

### What's the Cost?

UCI will cover up to 100 percent of the costs for those students who demonstrate need and meet published deadlines. We are among 20 public and private universities whose students graduate with the least amount of debt, and we are top-ranked among best values in public colleges.

Financial aid may take several forms: grants, scholarships, on-campus jobs, and student loans. Parent loans and payment plans are also available.

"Personal Expenses" include clothing, laundry and dry-cleaning, personal care, insurance, recreation, etc.

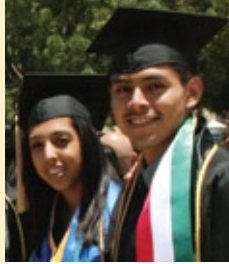
"Fees" include a mandatory health insurance fee and are subject to change. Nonresidents add \$20,608 to the annual fees.

### 2008

#### November 1-30

UC priority application filing period for fall quarter 2009 admission and scholarships. Students must file the application no later than November 30, 2008 for fall 2009. **Apply online at [www.universityofcalifornia.edu/apply](http://www.universityofcalifornia.edu/apply).**

#### December

Last opportunity for fall quarter freshmen applicants to take SAT Reasoning Test, SAT Subject Tests, and ACT Test.

### 2009

#### March 1-31

UCI notifies freshman applicants of their admissions status.

#### March 2

Priority deadline for filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and GPA verification form for Cal Grant consideration.

#### April 18

"Celebrate UCI" – campus-wide open house.

#### May 1

Freshmen Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) and Statement of Legal Residence (SLR) due.

#### May 1

Priority deadline for UCI to receive all required supporting documents to complete students' financial aid applications.

#### May 1

Housing applications due.

#### July 15

Final transcripts due to the Office of Admissions and Relations with Schools.
